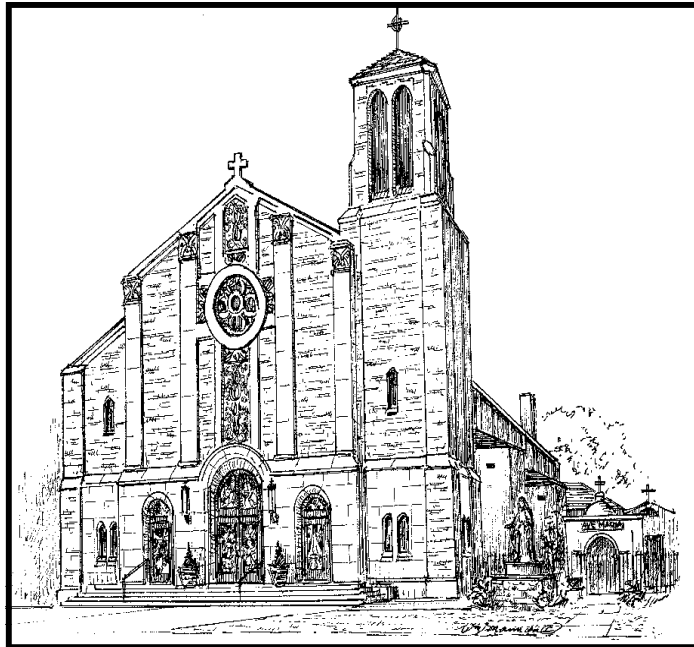

## UPDATE ON PARISH WORK

We welcome the news that Archbishop Myers has consented to allowing us an advance on our disbursement of the Capital Campaign money. This money will be used to remediate both sacristy roofs and we hope that work will begin by the end of the month. We have hired a firm that deals directly with the Office of Property Management of the Archdiocese of Newark. We are grateful to Archbishop Myers in showing such confidence in us!

In regard to our Parish Center: we have raised to date, **\$17,488.00**, the scope of the work, which would include a complete renovation of the room closest to the parking lot will warrant an amount greater than that which we have collected.

We are currently exploring different contractors and bids to give us the best price for all the hard work that needs.

We still need your help! The parish center is crucial to the life of our parish, we educate our children of the CCD program, in addition to the dozens of fundraisers held there through out the year to keep us going!

The time has come to start planning our Annual Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. In keeping with tradition, the novena in honor of Our Lady will begin on July 7th at 7:00pm and continue for 9 evenings including weekends. Celebrate and give thanks with us to almighty God and Mary, our Mother, for these 126 years of Grace.

Established in 1890, Our Lady of Mount Carmel church is the mother Church for the Italian Immigrants of Newark's historic Ironbound section. Today, "down neck" is filled with many different ethnicities, all of which take the time to celebrate their many religious and cultural festivals. We too, have a legacy of keeping alive our numerous Italian—American traditions, such as celebrating the feast day of our patroness.

For 126 years, we have celebrated the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel with an Italian Street Festival and many spiritual celebrations. Each year thousands of people come to celebrate with us during the 5 day festival. This old world street festival brings together friends new and old and draws the local community to our quaint little part of Oliver Street along side Independence Park.

This year "The Feast" as it is more commonly called, begins on Wednesday July 13th and continues through Sunday July 17th from 6:00pm—11:00pm each evening. The success of this feast depends on the kindness and generosity of our sponsors. The costs can be a staggering \$20,000 just to "turn on the lights" on opening night. It is solely through donations from our friends and business owners in our neighborhood that we are able to continue this magnificent tradition.
